In pursuance of Sub-Rule 5 (Rule 6 of Jammu and Kashmir, Civil Service Medical Attendance cum-Allowance) Rules, 1990. and as per approval of the Competent Authority, post facto sanction is, hereby accorded to the reimbursement of medical expenses to the tune of Rs. 9,62,154/- (Rupees Nine lakh sixty two thousand one hundred and fifty four only) in favour of Mr. Jameel Ahmad Nawab, Pump Operator, Municipal Corporation Srinagar, for treatment of his wife at *Narayan Super Speciality Hospital, Gurugram*, subject to the following conditions:-

- Reimbursement of charges shall be restricted to items/procedures admissible under rules and cost thereof restricted to the extent of rates as applicable to such items/procedures at AIIMS New Delhi.
- All relevant medical bills/vouchers are verified from the concerned medical authority of the hospital where from treatment has been taken.
- Essentiality certificate on Form 2 issued by the hospital authorities is obtained and kept on records.
