The key functions of the State Level Technical Committee shall be :-

1. Approve the technical parameters such as scope, objectives and final deliverables of the project and internal Bench Mark (IBM)/deciding basic parameters/approval of bid documents. Evaluation criteria and payment schedules after taking into consideration manuals, guidelines and advisories issued by the Ministry of Urban Development from time to time in relevant sector.
2. Incorporate resilience and secure projects against disasters –secure and structural norms are included in the design.
3. While giving technical sanction, the SLTC will make sure that contingencies or cost escalation are not included in the estimates and all the technical and financial norms of the JnNURM are followed in estimate preparation, technical sanction of projects, tender acceptance, extension etc.
4. While giving technical sanctions, the SLTC shall also examine the internal Rate of Return (IRR) both FIRR and EIRR and Recurring cost of capital expenditure and also approve the tenders.

5. The Committee will take corrective action on the reports of IRMA and other quality control reports.
6. Approve tenders.
7. the Committee will analyze the project funds like project-wise installment release to be submitted by ULBs to State as per Annexure 6.1 and take corrective action to ensure timely completion of projects without any escalation in costs.
8. the Committee will also appoint Project Development and Management Consultants (PDMCs).
