**Subject:-** Release Revalidated Grant-in-Aid of Rs. 30.00 crore Centre Share 1<sup>st</sup> instalment for implementation of the project namely "Pollution Abatement of Rivers Devika and Tawi at Udhampur under NRCP" during 2018-19.

Sanction is hereby accorded to the release of revalidated amount of **Rs. Rs.30.00 Crore (Rupees Thirty Crore only)** in favour of Chief Engineer, J&K Urban Environmental Engineering Department (UEED) as 1<sup>st</sup> instalment of Central share of 2018-19 for its utilization on account of implementation of the project namely "**Pollution Abatement of Rivers Devika and Tawi at Udhampur under National River Conservation Plan( NRCP)**" during 2019-20.

The Director Finance H&UDD shall draw the funds in advance from treasury through WDC Bill and credit the same in the official Bank Account of Chief Engineer J&K UEED, operated by CE, J&K UEED and Accounts Officer J&K UEED bearing Account No. 0110040510000024 maintained at J&K Bank Moving Branch Civil Secretariat, Srinagar/Jammu for implementation/execution of the project.

The release & subsequent utilization of funds is subject to the following conditions that:-

- i) the release of funds does not confer the sanction to incur the expenditure which should be booked only after observing all codal formalities;
- ii) the funds shall be utilized strictly in accordance with the Guidelines of the scheme and for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned;
- iii) the funds shall be utilized for execution of the scheme strictly as per originally approved components and according to GOI's prescribed guidelines which have been technically sanctioned and administratively approved by the Competent Authority;
- iv) the funds released for the project should be operated upon by the CE UEED through a separate interest earning bank account. The interest thus earned should be credited to the project and reflected in the Utilization Certificate from time to

time and shall be adjusted towards future funds released for the project and for any diversion of funds, the signatory of the bank account shall be held responsible.

- v) the implementing agency shall ensure that there is no overlapping of funds for the works being executed;
- vi) the funds so released shall not be available for any re-appropriation/diversion;
- vii) the choice of technology for Sewage Treatment Plants (STPs) shall be left open during the tendering process by the UEED and will be guided by the least life cycle and latest effluent discharge standard must be achieved.
- viii) details design and engineering of the STPs based on proper survey and investigations before execution shall be ensured by the UEED to achieve economy in the proposal as well as to avoid any shortfall in the design. All construction works proposed in the project shall be designed in accordance with the relevant codes for earthquake design and NDMA guidelines;
- ix) the UEED shall ensure socio-economic impact of the project at different stages i.e. pre-execution, during execution and post-execution . In this regard, a study to be carried out through independent institution/consultant and cost involving for the study borne out of centage charges provided under the project. Terms of Reference (ToR) in this regard may be shared with NRCD.
- x) the expenditure shall commensurate with the physical progress achieved;
- xi) the implementing agency shall ensure effective control of industrial pollution as per existing environmental laws and would ensure that the industries treat their effluents to prescribed standards before discharge into the sewerage system/river.
- xii) the implementing agency shall ensure stakeholder consultations during implementation of the project. The suggestions made are to be taken care of, during implementation stage. Benefits of project should adequately propagated in the public through mass awareness components.
- xiii) the implementing agency has to expeditiously share the layout/alignment of sewer lines as well as geo-coordinates of STP and other allied works for the purpose of GIS monitoring after sanction of the project
- xiv) for construction of STP, the implementing agency shall obtain consent under the Water Act, 1974 from the State Pollution Control Board and after commission of the STP "consent to operate" under the Act would also be obtained from the State Pollution Control Board on regular basis.
- xv) the implementing agency shall adhere to the guidelines of Bureau of Energy Efficiency and other related guidelines for energy efficiency building etc to be complied with.
- xvi) all video graphic/photographic evidence of works both shall be maintained.
- xvii) the funds for the project should be operated by the UEED through a separate interest earning bank account. The interest thus earned should be credited to the project and reflected in the UCs from time to time and shall be adjusted towards future funds released for the project and any diversion of funds, the signatory of the bank account shall be held responsible.
- xviii) the physical and financial progress report alongwith Utilization Certificate of the funds released shall be furnished as early as possible and definitely well before 31.3.2020 to GOI, with a copy to Finance Department.


